

On the afternoon of October 6, 2018, a modified SUV limo crash in Schoharie, New York resulted in 20 fatalities. The limo was transporting 17 passengers when it failed to stop at a stop sign at a T-shaped intersection. After passing through the intersection, the limo struck two pedestrians before hitting a parked vehicle in a parking lot. All 17 passengers, the driver and two pedestrians that were hit died. This accident was the deadliest road transportation disaster in the US since 2005.
